## **Case 14082013 - Disciplinary Action**

Ms. CHAN Kwan Yee Kirby was found, after the hearings on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2015 and 28<sup>th</sup> November 2015 by Discipline Board (Case No. 14082013) conducted in accordance with the 2013 By-Laws of the Hong Kong Psychological Society Limited (HKPS), to have contravened the following sections of the Code of Professional Conduct (2012) of HKPS between 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2013 and 12<sup>th</sup> September 2013 while being a Graduate Member:-
